
#### The Bucklesham Bugle

#### **Community Council News**

It is with regret that we have to tell you that Roly Burrows has stepped down from the Chairmanship of the Bucklesham and Foxhall Community Council. We felt that given the commitment Roly has given to the Community Council and the village, that we wanted to thank him through this newsletter. Roly has been at the helm since he took over the Community Council, at the request of the then Parish Council Chairman, in the year 2000 when the current Community Council did not have sufficient members to continue.

Since then Roly has been the driving force behind everything the Community Council has done. His enthusiasm and ideas have led to many and varied events being put on over the years. Our regular fundraising events have enabled us to put on, at Roly's suggestion, First Aid, Self-Defence and Art Classes and also to sponsor local groups such as the village choir and the First Orwell Sea Scouts. He also came up with the idea of the Annual Scarecrow Competition.

However, Roly's biggest achievement has to be the instigation of the annual Christmas Concert which in 2016 will see its 18<sup>th</sup> year. What started as Roly's idea for a Millennium Concert for the people in the village to show off their talents has escalated in to an annual concert that regularly sells out before the tickets go on sale. Over the years Roly has invested a lot of time and money to enhance and improve the show. The concert regularly raises over £1,000 annually (as well as holding a charity night) and is the main reason why the Community Council has been able to support the other groups and events which it has put on and to continue to maintain the playing field. Moreover, it enabled the Community Council to make a donation of £2,500 to the Village Hall to secure a grant from BIFFA for the recent renovations.
