The Parish Council are delighted to bring you our New Year edition of the Bugle.

We have written to Gladmans Developments to express our observations and concerns over the plans for the Orwell Green Garden Village in the neighbouring village of Foxhall. Huge thanks to all those who shared their

opinions with us in order for us to collate a balanced and constructive response. The Parish Council have advised Gladmans we will not be supporting a planning application should one be submitted, but at this stage we are merely giving them feedback on their proposals. As yet there is not an opportunity for us to object to a planning permission application. The deadline for feedback as part of their consultation is Friday 21st December 2018. After this, Gladmans say they will assess, collate and act upon the feedback. We will of course keep you all informed of any news we are given, however the best place to keep up to date will no doubt be the local press. If villagers wish to write to SCDC in advance of Gladmans seeking planning permission we advise that you also write again once planning has been sought. Letters written before a planning application is submitted may not count as a registered objection. The likely next step if a planning application is submitted would be for a representative of the Parish Council to work with other neighbouring Parish Councils and interested parties in some form of working group which will scrutinise the proposals, as we are doing with the Innocence Lane development.

In the event of bad weather there are piles of sand and salt throughout the village for spreading on the roads and paths. Please feel free to help out your fellow villagers by spreading it on the snow and ice as and when necessary.

The Parish Council would like to take this opportunity to wish all villagers a very happy and healthy New Year.
