

Bucklesham Playing Field ~ Rules for Use

This Playing Field is held in Trust and managed by Bucklesham Parish Council

Opening Hours

The Playing Field is open from dawn until dusk. No one is permitted on the Playing Field outside of these hours unless in an emergency.

Litter

All litter must be disposed of in the bins provided or taken home.

Vehicles

No motorised or electric vehicles are permitted outside of the car park, except for mobility scooters.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome if kept under control, and must be cleaned up after immediately if the dog has fouled on the field. Failure to do so may result in a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued by East Suffolk Council.

Play Area

Children using the play area must always be accompanied by an adult.

Goals

Children using the goals must always be supervised by an adult.

Fires

No fires or barbeques are permitted.

Trading

No trading of any kind is permitted to take place on the Playing Field.

Noise

Excessive shouting, singing, playing of musical instruments or loud music is not permitted.

Any anti-social behaviour may be reported to the Police

The Playing Field Conveyance states that users of the field must not:

“do or permit or suffer to be done any act or thing upon or about the said property which shall or may grow to be an annoyance, nuisance, damage or disturbance to the owners or occupiers of the neighbouring land”

All rules must be followed by all users of the Playing Field unless specific permission is granted by Bucklesham Parish Council.
